This thematic issue under the aegis of EFI's Forest Policy Research Network (FPRN) and IUFRO 09.05.04 Forest Policies in Baltics and CEE Region.

The Baltics, Central Eastern (CEE) and South-eastern (SEE) European region has been at the forefront of dynamic changes, including in forest policy and governance domain, especially in the context of its integration with the European research agenda. Over the past three decades, these countries have navigated through significant political, economic, and environmental transformations, shaping the trajectory of forest management practices and policies. This thematic issue seeks to explore the multifaceted dimensions of forest policy and governance within the Baltic, CEE and SEE countries, offering insights into the evolution of diverse institutional frameworks and contexts and their alignment with broader European frameworks.

## **Central European Forestry Journal**

Journal has been issued by National Forest Centre (Slovakia) and the Czech University of Life Sciences. It is a regional, open access, peer-reviewed journal, with an impact factor (1.4 for 2023) and Q2 ranking within the Forestry in the Web of Science (WOS). There are four issues per year. Thematic issue in forest policy and governance is planned in the second half of 2025 (issue no. 3 or no. 4).

## **Procedure and dates**

Central European Forestry Journal has 6 papers per issue. One paper could be an overview paper (with multi-authors) and 5 papers handle issues within the thematic field. Exclusively research articles and review articles are invited. Contributions in the form of literature reviews, theorybased empirically-analytical research, or conceptual/theoretical/methodological works, employing qualitative, quantitative, or mixed-methods are welcome. Submissions may focus on single countries or adopt a comparative perspective across multiple countries within the Baltic and CEE, including SEE region.

We especially welcome contributions of research teams made of a young scientists and senior researcher(s), from different countries, who have results ready to publish. Quality papers with young scientist as a first author will be prioritized.

Submission deadline: Manuscripts can be submitted until 3. February 2025

Finalization of a thematic issue in either August or November 2025 (issue no. 3 or no. 4), depending on a peer-review.
